Renewable Energy from ACEN

The Stubbo Solar project is a 400-megawatt (MW) renewable energy project that was approved by the NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment in July 2021. It is being built across 1,250 hectares of mostly cleared grazing land, 10km north of Gulgong. The main site entrance is via Blue Springs Road.

The project is expected to create up to 400 jobs during construction, up to 10 ongoing jobs and contracting opportunities for local businesses.

Preconstruction works commenced in late 2022, with road upgrade and internal access roads being completed the first half of 2023.

Our site mobilisation efforts will begin in mid-July over the next few months, which will include the development of a site compound for our project team as well as material being delivered to site.

We anticipate that our site offices and facilities will be finished by the end of September. The Switchyard and Solar project earthworks will commence in parallel with the site establishment works and will be ongoing for the remainder of 2023.

Bushfire planning and management

In the coming weeks, contractors will be carrying out controlled clearing burns on our Stubbo Solar project site.

You may notice smoke coming from the Stubbo area, however this work will be coordinated with the NSW Rural Fire Service Mudgee HQ (the RFS) and a qualified third party subcontractor recommended by the RFS.

This bushfire hazard reduction work is an important safety management part of our site preparation works.
