

# Birriwa Solar

Renewable Energy from ACEN

The Birriwa Solar and Battery project's Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) was placed on public exhibition in October/November 2022. A Response to Submissions Report (RTS) is being finalised to consider and respond to the issues raised during public exhibition of the EIS.

Following submission of the RTS report and a separate amendment report, the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) will prepare an assessment report and provide their recommendation to the Independent Planning Commission (IPC) to make a determination on the project. The expected timing for the IPC hearing is still to be confirmed but is likely in 2024.

In response to matters raised in the EIS submissions by agencies, the community and stakeholders, we have made some amendments to the project that we wish to share with you

The Birriwa Solar and Battery Project is a 600-megawatt renewable energy project that is being proposed across an area of approximately 1,200 hectares of mostly cleared grazing land, about 20km southeast of Dunedoo, in the Birriwa district. It will generate enough energy to power approximately 262,000 average Australian homes.
