ACEN Australia is in the early stages of planning the Narragamba Solar project, a 320 MW Solar project, near our Stubbo Solar project.

Our proposed development footprint covers an area of approximately 750 hectares with a range of technical, environmental, cultural, social and economic assessments to inform approvals and permitting currently being undertaken.

The project will connect to new transmission infrastructure developed by the Energy Corporation of NSW (EnergyCo) as part of the Central-West Orana Renewable Energy Zone.

ACEN Australia is currently constructing the 400 MW Stubbo Solar project, off Blue Springs Road, in Gulgong.
