March 2024 Update



Work on our Stubbo Solar project is progressing well and we have installed just over 100,000 solar panels to date.

Transgrid and Zinfra are building our switchyard for the project. Our Stubbo Solar construction team, PCL Construction and their subcontractor, EPEC Group, are working on the construction of our substation.

Substations are a vital piece of infrastructure for any solar project. This is where all the energy produced by the solar panels are collected and converted by transformers to the high voltage transmission network.

They are necessary to ensure that as little energy as possible is lost during transmission over long distances.

By the time this article goes to print, we would have received the first of two transformers we will be using on the project.
