In 2023, ACEN Australia secured a 20 year Long Term Energy Service Agreement (LTESA) for Stubbo Solar in the NSW Government's first renewable energy and storage auction.

The LTESA is a risk management mechanism that will support the project in the future if the National Electricity Market moves into a sustained period of low prices. In return for the long term insurance value provided by the LTESA.
