ACEN Australia is progressing our plans to develop the Narragamba Solar project, a 320 MW Solar project, near our Stubbo Solar project, close to Gulgong.

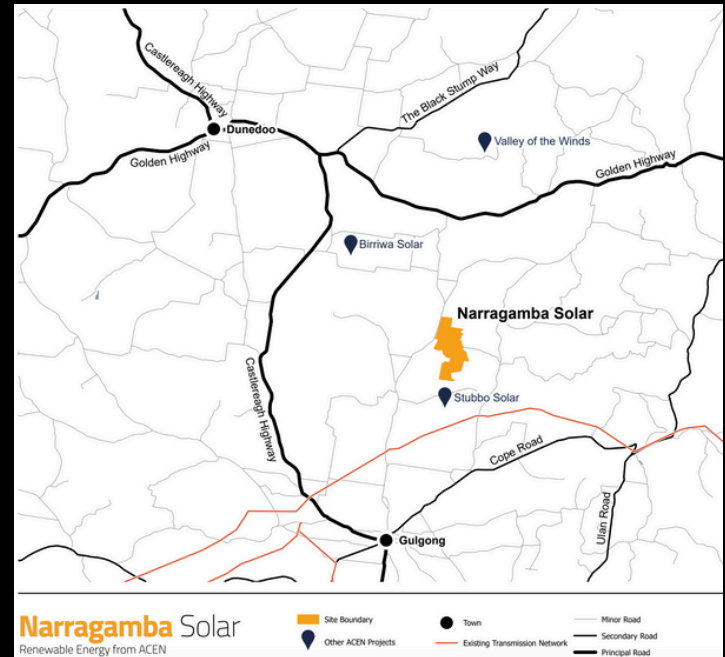
We would like to thank the community for their feedback on our proposed development footprint.
