Electrical and site preparation works

Civil and site preparation works have been in full swing this year in preparation for the delivery of a new 250 MVA electrical transformer.

An extra bay has been built to accommodate the transformer, which is an essential piece of electrical equipment to help safely transfer power between our new 400 megawatt hour Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) and the electricity grid.

The 261 tonne transformer will be trucked from Brisbane on a specially designed over-sized truck and carefully moved into position in its new bay. Further assembly and electrical connection work will then take place. It is expected to arrive on site at the end of the month.

Sealing last section of Big Ridge Road

Work to seal the last kilometre of Big Ridge Road is now scheduled to take place later this month. The works will only impact vehicles entering and exiting the existing solar site. Works are expected to be completed in one to two weeks.
