Our Stubbo Solar project has been in construction since late 2022, and is nearing completion.

We are in what is referred to as the <u>commissioning stage</u> of the project. This is a crucial step in the project and is part of the process of ensuring that equipment is correctly installed and operates as intended.

The project has received Generator Registration and is currently exporting to the National Electricity Market (NEM).

Earlier in the year, Stubbo Solar successfully exported 100MW of renewable energy to the NEM.

Stubbo Solar is a 400-megawatt (MW) large scale solar project being constructed by our contracting partner PCL Construction.

ACEN Australia's Stubbo Solar Social Investment Program (SIP) is our voluntary contribution to Gulgong and surrounding communities.

Totalling \$200,000 throughout the construction period, funding is available to not-for profit organisations and activities that directly benefit and enhance the liveability and vibrancy of our local community.
